The Notice of Availability of the Draft EIS/OEIS was published in the Federal Register on Aug. 19, 2022.

The Navy invites the public to review the Draft EIS/OEIS and welcomes comments that are substantive to the accuracy and adequacy of the environmental impact analysis.
